The challenging lyrics and beautiful music of *African Jigsaw* raise awareness that in the city, extreme poverty is only a few steps away from wealth and vitality. Developed countries, including Canada, share many of the same problems, although perhaps to a lesser degree. We need to consider how we might go about solving this imbalance of wealth. *African Jigsaw* does not offer the answers but instead paints a sympathetic and touching picture that reveals many pieces of the puzzle.
